Jan 16: The International Centre-Goa, in collaboration with the Brazilian Chair at the Department of Sociology, Goa University, will hold a discussion on 'Urban violence' at the International Centre, Dona Paula on January 23 at 5 p.m.

The discussion will be initiated by Prof Michel Misse, a senior sociologist at the Federal University of Rio de Janeiro with a presentation on 'Exchanging experiences on urban violence: A comparative perspective of Rio city of Brazil and Goa

Prof Michel Misse is the director of the Centre of Studies of Urban Violence at the Rio de Janeiro University with a PhD in sociology from Candido Mendes University, Brazil.

The presentation by Prof Misse will be followed by another presentation by Mr Muktesh Chander, IPS, deputy inspector general of police, Goa on 'Cyber crime: the new facet of urban criminology' wherein he will analyse how the Cyber communication can be a sophisticated mechanism for harbouring criminal activities and how the problem can be addressed by safety mechanism.

Mr Muktesh Chander is a 1988 batch Indian Police Service officer studying cyber laws and crimes.
